5. Benedictus

We bless every relationship within each household, that there may be peace and love and understanding flowing between each person. In the name of Jesus, we bless every network of wholesome and supportive friendship.

We speak to the Christian churches, and we bless you in the name of the Lord that the Holy Spirit and the Word of God may flow out from you in power. We bless the hearts of all who live in this community that you may be quickened to hear and respond to the voice of the Living God. We bless all who live and work here, that the overspill of the blessings of the presence of the Kingdom of God may fall upon you.
